# Present Simple

- повторяющееся, регулярное действие;
- констатация факта;
- характеристика способностей, привычек, взглядов, ... ;
- с глаголами восприятия, желания, владения (to see, hear, to want, to like...)

# Present Simple

- usually, every day/night/  
morning/month/week/year ...
- often, always, seldom, rarely...
- once/twice/three times a  
week/day/year...

# Present Simple

- I **clean** the room twice a week.
- We **clean** the room twice a week.
- You **clean** the room twice a week.
- He **cleans** the room twice a week.
- She **cleans** the room twice a week.
- It **cleans** the room twice a week.
- They **clean** the room twice a week.

• на s, x, z, sh, ch, o	+es	to box – boxes to wash – washes to watch – watches to go – goes
• на согласную+y	y → i + es	to study – studies ! to play – plays

- I **know** it. – Я знаю это.
- We **know** it. – Мы знаем это.
- You **know** it. – Вы знаете это.
- He **knows** it. – Он знает это.

# Present Simple

## отрицательные предложения

- I **don't know** it. – Я не знаю этого.
- We **don't know** it. – Мы не знаем этого.
- You **don't know** it. – Вы не знаете этого.
- He **doesn't know** it. – Он не знает этого.
- She **doesn't know** it. – Она не знает этого.
- It **doesn't know** it. – Он\она\оно не знает этого.
- They **don't know** it. – Они не знают этого.



# Present Simple

- **Do I clean** the room twice a week? Yes, I do. No, I don't.
- **Do we clean** the room twice a week? Yes, we do. No, we don't.
- **Do you clean** the room twice a week? Yes, you/I do. No, you/I don't.
- **Does he clean** the room twice a week? Yes, he does. No, he doesn't.
- **Does she clean** the room twice a week? Yes, she does. No, she doesn't.
- **Does it clean** the room twice a week? Yes, it does. No, it doesn't.
- **Do they clean** the room twice a week? Yes, they do. No, they don't.

# Present Simple

## вопросительные предложения

- **Do I know** it? Yes, I do. No, I don't. – Я знаю это? – Да. Нет.
- **Do we know** it? Yes, we do. No, we don't. – Мы знаем это?
- **Do you know** it? Yes, you/I do. No, you/I don't. – Вы знаете это?
- **Does he know** it? Yes, he does. No, he doesn't. – Он знает это?
- **Does she know** it? Yes, she does. No, she doesn't. – Она знает это?
- **Does it know** it? Yes, it does. No, it doesn't. – Он\она знает это?
- **Do they know** it? Yes, they do. No, they don't. – Они знает это?

- How often **does she clean** the room?
- What **do you know**?
